- **1. Dates**: August 10 (Sun) August 15 (Fri), 2025 (6 days, 5 nights)
- 2. Participants per university: 4 individuals (3 students + 1 accompanying faculty)
 - * Due to dormitory arrangements, **only female participants** (including accompanying faculty) may join.
 - * The dormitory is arranged as shared rooms (2 people per room); one student will be assigned to share a room with a female student from another university.
- 3. Program Highlights (subject to change)
- (Introduction) Orientation & Campus Tour
- (Cultural Classes) Traditional Korean games, Korean cuisine, Taekwondo
- (Cultural Experiences) Visit to the National Hangeul Museum & workshop, Gyeongbokgung Palace tour (hanbok experience), Korean baseball game
- (Free time) Guided visits to Seoul landmarks (Banpo Hangang Park, Insadong, N Seoul Tower)
