

# 2025 SNUE Summer Korean Language and Culture Program

## - Application Guidelines -

♠ The Center for International Exchange at SNUE is pleased to invite students and faculty members from our partner universities to participate in our Korean Language and Culture Program. This six-day program is designed to provide a deeper understanding of Korean culture through hands-on experiences and educational activities.

### □ Program Overview

**1. Dates:** August 10 (Sun) – August 15 (Fri), 2025 (6 days, 5 nights)

**2. Participants per university:** 4 individuals (3 students + 1 accompanying faculty)

※ Due to dormitory arrangements, **only female participants** (including accompanying faculty) may join.

※ The dormitory is arranged as shared rooms (2 people per room); one student will be assigned to share a room with a female student from another university.

**3. Program Highlights** (subject to change)

○ **(Introduction)** Orientation & Campus Tour

○ **(Cultural Classes)** Traditional Korean games, Korean cuisine, Taekwondo

○ **(Cultural Experiences)** Visit to the National Hangeul Museum & workshop, Gyeongbokgung Palace tour (hanbok experience), Korean baseball game

○ **(Free time)** Guided visits to Seoul landmarks (Banpo Hangang Park, Insadong, N Seoul Tower)

**4. Participation Fee**

○ **(Free of charge)** Breakfast & lunch, accommodation, program activities

○ **(Not included)** Round-trip airfare, travel insurance

※ Participants must purchase their own international round-trip tickets to/from Incheon International Airport, aligned with the group arrival/departure schedule. Details will be provided later.

※ Each participant must arrange their own travel insurance and bring a copy of the policy to Korea.

○ **(Expenses Covered by SNUE)**

□ Admission and workshop fees at all program venues

□ Dormitory accommodation (5 nights, double occupancy, female-only dorms)

■ Room facilities: Bed, desk, refrigerator

■ Note: Toiletries and personal items (e.g., hairdryer) are not provided

※ Airport pick-up and drop-off shuttle buses (one time pick-up shuttle bus and one time drop-off shuttle bus, so participants are encouraged to arrive at Incheon International Airport as a group)

□ Breakfast & lunch throughout the program

□ KRW 10,000 subsidy for transportation card

□ All other general program expenses

○ **(Expenses Not Covered)**

□ Round-trip international airfare

□ Personal expenses during free time

□ Dinner / Travel insurance

## 5. Rules & Safety Guidelines

○ Daily curfew in effect; overnight stays outside the dormitory are not permitted

○ Please actively cooperate with the 24-hour safety supervision provided by the accompanying faculty of each university.
